Terms and Conditions for the use of the School and Canter Tracks

By hiring either the school or canter tracks, it is assumed that you have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Horsebox parking is on the hardcore area in front of the white shed, a separate car park is opposite the office on the left.
- 2. When booking either the School or the grass tracks, it is a condition of use that a hat to the current BS, BE or BD standards must be worn. Body protectors are recommended and must be worn by children under the age of 16. Approved riding footwear must also be worn.
- 3. It is required that anyone using the canter tracks is accompanied in case of accident. If riding unaccompanied, emergency contact details and an estimated finish time must be left with Ann Jones (07771 850115).
- 4. There is an abundance of wildlife on the farm therefore it is essential that you should be of a standard capable of controlling a horse in the open country. It is a working farm with the inherent risks that you would expect. These risks include, but are not limited to, the presence of heavy machinery, people undertaking maintenance tasks and livestock in adjoining fields.
- 5. Please leave the School as you find it with jumps put away and any droppings removed. A fork and skip can be found by the gate into the school.
- 6. Please remove any droppings and hay from the car park.
- 7. Please keep dogs on leads at all times and clear up after them.
- 8. Horses tied to horseboxes must not be left unattended.
- 9. When exercising in the school please close the gate on entry.
